There only needs to be one handler with the dog inside the training ring. You can switch when we take a bathroom break.


Class fees are due 48 hours before the 1st night of class in order to hold your spot in the class. We are limiting our classes to 4-5 students.

Cancellations

We ask that you give us a 48 hr notice if you have to cancel a lesson or not come to group training. This is due to limited availability on our calendar, travel schedule and many other factors. If you cancel before the 48 hr notice we will work with you and try to reschedule your lesson or get you caught up with the rest of the class. We reserve the right to cancel your lesson/class at anytime due to medical, travel or any unforeseen situations.

No Show

Your appointment is very important to us. However, we understand that unexpected situations may occur. We also accept Stripe (all major credit cards) through the ProPet software. It is particularly important that you log on frequently to your ProPet Profile. The first night of class I will have card processor so I can take payment then. But it is recommended to pay before the night of class. It is imperative that the class fee is paid on or before the first night of class. If you cannot pay, We can recycle you into another class at a later date. I do this only because you have taken up a spot that someone else could've had in a class and its unfair to those who are trying to get into a class.

Group Class Equipment List

The first part of our first class will be classroom, a notebook or note pad and pen to take notes (do not worry there's not a test LOL).

Do Not Feed your dog before Class. We want him/her hungry for treats and they will pay more attention to you.

3ft, 4t, or 6ft leash. Material does not matter.

Poop bags. I have a plethora of bags in my van so if you forget your just ask me for one. Everyone is expected to clean up after their dog. If this becomes a problem, I will have to add an inconvenience fee.

Favorite Toy. We will be testing drive during this first class to see if your dogs like treats or toys better to work with.

Treats & Treat bags. The treats need to be different from the treats you give at home. They also need to be small like dime size. I use hot dogs; you can slice them up and they are the perfect treat. Or string cheese, or Bil–Jac treats (can be found at any Petsmart or Feeder's Supply).

Flat Collar. We like to start at the bottom of the collar spectrum and work our way up. If your dog is medium size and up, we will most likely suggest a prong collar, so you have control. Every case is different, and we will not know until we see you and your dog. So, we will start with a regular flat collar.

And lastly Pl<mark>ease bring proof of Vaccinations (t</mark>he ones we are worried about is Rabies, Distemper and Bordatella Vaccines). Unless you have already sent it to us through the Propet Portal.



Introduction

Welcome to working with Evolution Dog Training! We look forward to getting to know you and your dog on your path to reaching your training goals.

This packet will give you an overview of what to expect while working with me. I realize that this may be your first time working with a professional dog trainer so in this packet you'll learn about what you can expect from me, what I'll expect from you, and how to prepare for the next steps so we can begin working together.

How Evolution Dog Training Programs Work

Over the next few weeks we'll work together as a team to improve or change your dog's behavior. Based on your dog's prior history, your family's situation, and the dog's daily environment, we will work with you to create a training plan that can be implemented quickly and effectively.

During our lessons, we will observe and explain your dog's behavior. We will then demonstrate and instruct you on how to implement some safe training techniques to change your dog's behavior. You'll learn about the science behind the behavior and the training techniques.

We consider ourselves positively-balanced trainers. Meaning that we do use adversives but only if necessary. We work on a force continuum if you will, we start at the lowest force and move up as necessary:

- 1. Flat Collar
- 2. Martingale
- 3. Choke
- 4. Prong Collar
- 5. E-Collar

All of our Dog Trainers have been trained on how to safely operate all 5 of these 13 collars and will pass the knowledge on to our clients to prevent injury.



What You Can Expect from Your Dog Trainer

Communication

We value timely communication and promise to respond quickly to your questions and feedback.

Our #1 mode of communication will be through our Propet Client Portal. Https:// evolutiondogtraining.propetware.com . We will also communicate through text/email so keep an eye out for notes, handouts, and reminders in your inbox. Please feel free to reach out through email or phone if you have questions.

Preparing for Lessons

WHEN? – If you are taking private lessons, we will meet at a cadence that suites your schedule and the goals we've set out to reach. We strongly recommend that we hold in person lessons once a week or every other week depending on your schedule and urgency of reaching your goals.

If you are taking group classes, the group will meet once a week for 6 or 7 consecutive weeks for approximately one hour. Please arrive a few minutes early to settle in and help your dog get acclimated to the environment.



WHO? – During lessons of any sort please be prepared to have all immediate family members attend. Everyone's participation, support, and execution will be critical to reach your training goals.

WHERE? – Private lessons will be held where your dog primarily needs to improve his or her behavior. This can be in your home, local park, or other familiar environment. If you are enrolled in group classes. The location will be included in the confirmation email that is sent out before each class.

What to Bring With You To Lessons or Classes

Please make sure you have the following handy for every lesson:

- At least 100 mini-M&M sized pieces of your dog's favorite treats
- One or two of your dog's favorite toys
- A 6ft leash for your dog
- A pen and notepad
- Poop bags in the case that we are meeting outside of your home
- A Positive and Fun Attitude

List of Reinforcers Your Dog May Enjoy Training With

Every dog has different preferences so we will work together to determine which rewards will work in which situations for the best results. The first night of classes or the first lesson we will find out what reinforcers work best for your dog. These are some common rewards you may want to consider:

- Hard treats (kibble, etc.)
- Soft treats (Cheese sticks, freeze-dried chicken, bagged training treats, etc.)
- Toys (Balls, stuffed toys, Kongs, nylabones, etc.)
- Touch (Ear scratches, belly rubs, etc.)
- Verbal praise



What to Expect During Lessons or Classes

During lessons we will be actively engaged in teaching you how to train your dog. We will provide step-by-step instructions as well as demonstrate the training exercises with your dog our with one of our demo dogs. You will be expected to practice during the lesson with light critiquing from me and then continue practicing in between lessons.

We will provide a handout during each lesson that outlines observations, training tasks to practice, and a brief explanation about the training exercises, if requested. Especially for group Classes. You will have to let us know if you want this service, it is free of charge.
